

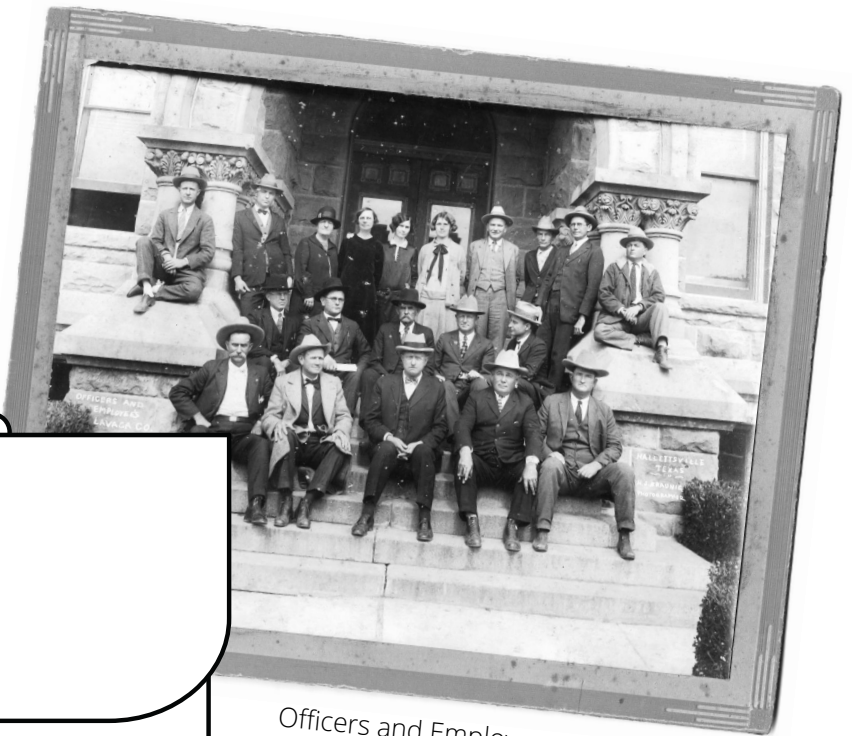
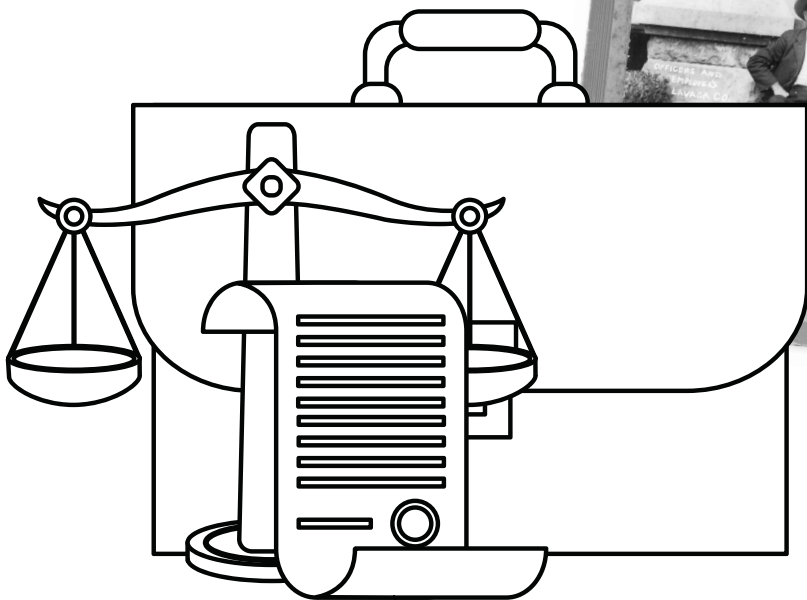
# 1920s Job Profile: Lawyer
